

Use recycled, biodegradable paper and traditional origami techniques to create a paper planter! Students will get to get their hands dirty while they plant a seedling. As a bonus, you can bury the entire planter box when the seedling is ready for transplant!

Remember to share your finished pieces by tagging us!

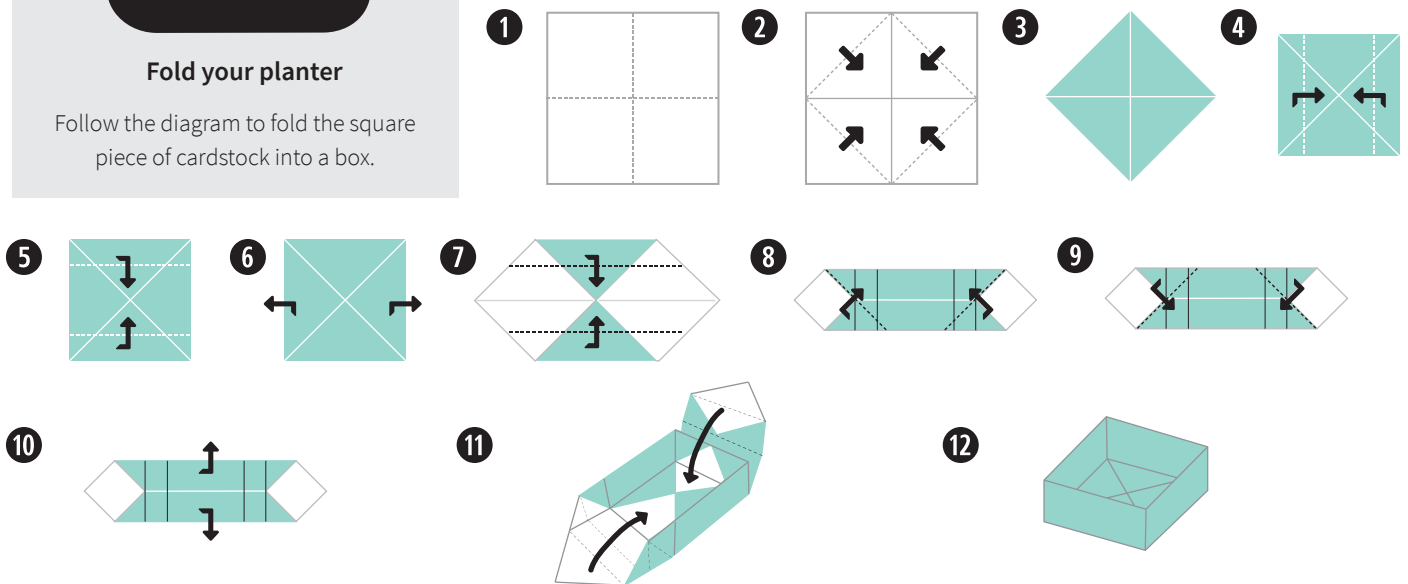
MATERIALS

- Repurposed paper, cardstock
- Soil
- Seeds

STEP ONE

Fold your planter

Follow the diagram to fold the square piece of cardstock into a box.



STEP TWO

Plant your seeds

Use a small cup to fill your origami box with soil.

Use your index finger to push a hole about one inch into the soil, and place seed into hole and gently cover with soil.

STEP THREE

Transfer your seedling

Once your seedling has outgrown its paper planter, transplant the seedling and origami box into a larger pot, cup, or in an outdoor garden.

STEP FOUR

Watch your plant grow!

Set your planter in a sunny spot, water regularly, and watch your plant grow!
