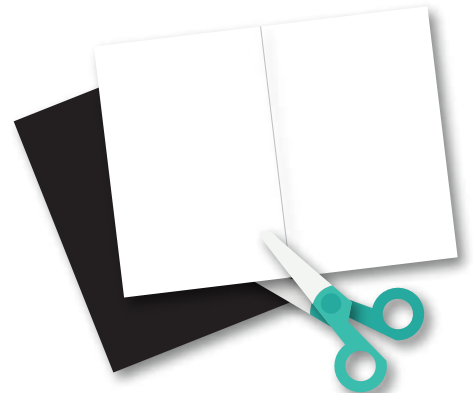


## Line Design

This project is all about using all different types of lines to create various designs. They can be any type of designs you desire, but remember to include balance and movement throughout your piece!

### MATERIALS

- Black Paper
- White Paper
- Pencil
- Sharpies (Fine Point & Extra Fine)
- Glue
- Scissors
- Ruler (optional)



### STEP ONE

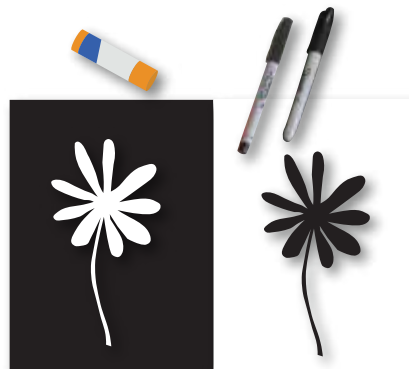
Take your black and white pieces of paper and fold them in half horizontally, then cut them in half.



### STEP TWO

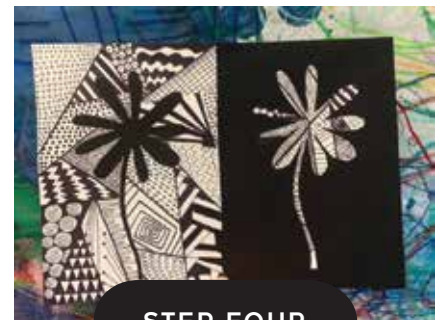
Next, take one black piece of paper and one white piece of paper and draw a silhouette. A **silhouette** is an outline of an object.

Start by drawing one first, then cut it out, and lay it on the other piece. Use the shape you just cut out and trace around it on the other sheet of paper so they can be exactly the same.



### STEP THREE

Then, take your glue stick and glue the white silhouette to the black rectangle and the black silhouette to the white rectangle. (You're gluing to the opposite color)



### STEP FOUR

Finally, take your ruler and section off each of your white areas. Then, fill each section with various designs. Remember to keep balance and movement in mind. That means, if you create a design that is dark, surround it with lighter designs and vice versa!
